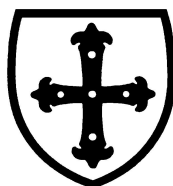


Junior Transport Policy



Old Whitgiftians Colts Cricket Club

Old Whitgiftians Cricket Club policy is that parents or other responsible adults are responsible for transporting players to and from all matches and practice sessions and therefore the Club will not be registering Private Vehicles for the transportation of individuals in connection with any fixtures or practice sessions arranged by the Club. The implementation of this policy is not intended to exclude any player from participation and parents or guardians should contact the Head Coach or Junior manager if they have any problems with the transportation of players to matches or practice sessions.

By returning this completed form, I agree to my son/daughter/child in my care taking part in the activities of the club.

I understand that I will be kept informed of these activities – for example timing and transport details.

I understand that in the event of any injury or illness all reasonable steps will be taken to contact me, and to deal with that injury/illness appropriately.
